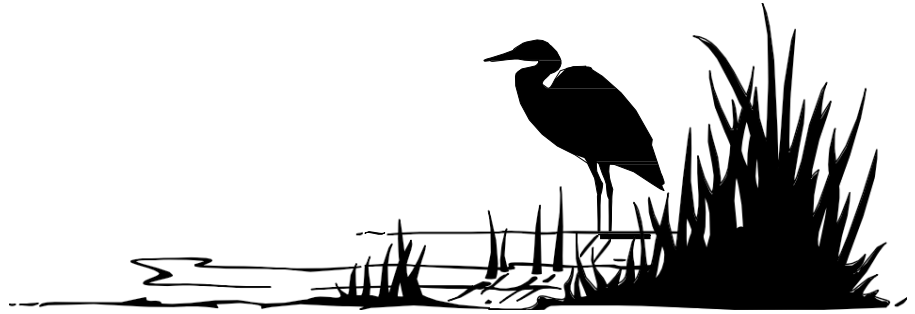

During our meeting on April 10, we had the pleasure of hearing from Mike Ellis, CEO of Healthcare Network of Southwest Florida.

Healthcare Network of Southwest Florida (Healthcare Network) is a private not-for-profit organization providing quality primary medical and dental care to our community since 1977. Their first facilities were two small trailers in Immokalee. From the start, the nonprofit was committed to providing basic medical and dental healthcare services at an affordable cost while ensuring dignity and respect to each individual served.

Mike Ellis, President and Chief Executive Officer

Background: Healthcare Network President, Mike Ellis, has a bachelor's degree in biology and a master's degree in both clinical chemistry and hospital and health administration.

Experience/Role: Mike has 37 years of healthcare experience including seven years as executive director of the Children's Hospital of Southwest Florida, 15 years executive experience in Community and Migrant Health Centers, and 15 years executive experience in hospital administration. Mike joined the Healthcare Network in 2013 as CEO.

Board Affiliations: Mike is a former member of the Lee Memorial Health System Board of Directors and currently serves on the Lee County Mosquito Control District Commission.

The challenge of the future is to first prevent illness whenever possible, curtail its development by whatever means feasible, treat the individual with optimal care and to ensure these measures are available to everyone."

Mike shared that the requirements to qualify including:

- Good Budgeting/ yearly audit
- Quality checks for doctors
- 60% of children in Collier County use the services.

There are 420 employees, 40 Doctors, 17 Dentist and they receive 205,000 visits a year. There are 21 facilities with a \$50M budget annually.

The estimate of the economic impact is \$65M a year from employee spending at local businesses including restaurants.

Key Initiatives:

- Children's dental program.
- Adding additional pediatric dentists.
- This program is the only program between Tampa and Miami that works with special needs children, taking care of 1200 last year that needed anesthesia for their dentist visit.
- Beautiful Minds Initiative. They have integrated psychologist into every practice. This will help identify psychological issues in young children and young adults sooner. If a doctor is meeting with a patient and they feel that the patient, they can simply walk them down the hall and do a "warm hand off" to make sure they get the help they need quickly and without any referrals.
