The Wheelchair Foundation – The Rotary Club of Naples has decided to ramp up its efforts this year to raise money to purchase wheelchairs for the Wheelchair Foundation.

A long-time member of the Rotary Club of Naples, Dr. Phil Regala, an orthopedic surgeon, travels to Haiti once or twice a year on a medical mission. As a surgeon who tries to repair broken bones, he knows first-hand the need for wheelchairs throughout Haiti. He personally committed \$1,000 toward a container of wheelchairs (110) and The Rotary Club of Naples committed an additional \$2,000. We need to raise another \$8,000 for a total of \$11,000 per container.

With the help of District Chair Steve Agius, the Rotary Club of Naples is holding a fun social and fundraising event for Rotarians and their friends. In addition to raising money to ship a container of wheelchairs to Haiti, we may even interest others in the community to learn more about Rotary and how to become a member. This is a Collier County-wide Rotary event from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 20, at the

Naples Beach Hotel & Golf Club. This social event will include a short program by Steve Agius and then he will do a cash call. The Rotary Club of Naples Bay has committed to partner in this event, and Tim Miller is working to collect funds for this worthy cause. On September 3rd we heard from Al Wagner, CEO of TruPayroll on Marco Island. Al has been actively networking in Naples and Ft. Myers for over 2 years and spoke to our club about how to properly network for our club. Al expressed that when you meet someone you shouldn't immediately try to figure out what they can do for you, rather you should ask what you can do for them. Building relationships and friendships is how you should look at each person that you meet.

When Al first arrived at our meeting, he sat across from John Lamb. When he stood to speak he gave us a break down of everything that he has learned about John in the short amount of time that he sat across from him. He shared what John does for a living, information about his family, the length of time he has been in Naples and other interesting things. He did this to show the club how easy it is to get to know someone and figure out what you can do for them. The best way to get a referral is to give a referral.

Al said he has learned several different acronyms that he uses to help his talk to people that he has never met. "Two years ago I couldn't have dreamed that I would be standing in front of a group speaking about networking, but I have come out of my shell and public speaking feels natural to me now" Al commented.
