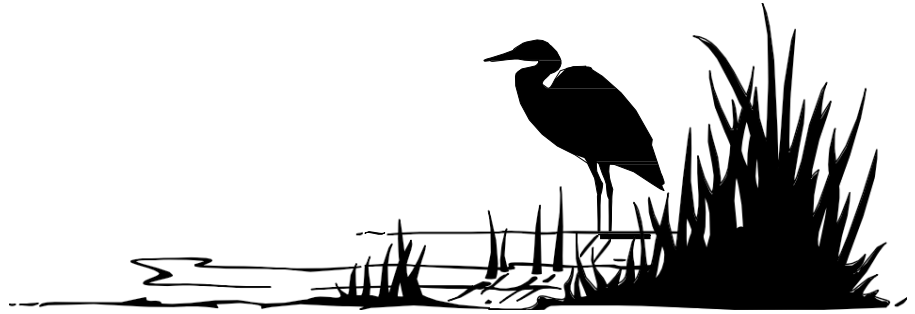

District Governor's X 5!!



We were honored to have 5 former District Governors at our meeting. How cool is that!?

Rich Kirschner took a few minutes of our meeting to discuss RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Awards) and Rotary Youth Exchange.

RYLA sends students for a 4 day camp at Lake Placid Camp <https://www.lpccc.net/> where they learn about leadership skills as well as learning about Rotary. Rich explained that after they leave this camp they know as much about Rotary as most members. Our club is sponsoring a student but the student has not been identified yet. They need to be a Freshman or a Sophomore in High School. At last years camp they learned to prepare for a disaster, what materials to take, what to leave behind. In 1.5

hours they packed 27,000 meals. They also made ethnically acceptable dolls for central and south America that were sent with wheel chairs.

Regarding the Rotary Youth Exchange, Rich said that our district is hosting 6 Rotary youth this year. They will be here for 12 weeks and will spend time with multiple Rotarian's. Next year the plan is to host 10 students. All of these students will attend RYLA!

Rich took this opportunity to share with us that our club has points that can be used to help new Rotarians earn their first Paul Harris Award. He said that the District can donate 333 points, the club can donate 333 points and the member can donate \$333 and they can receive their first Paul Harris Award.



Sargent Jim Baker presented information about the Drone Unit as assigned to the Bureau of Technical Services for the Collier County Sheriffs Department.

In the beginning drones were only allowed to be used indoors, anything out doors is controlled by the FAA.

Soon, they were allowed to go outdoors and now they have 19 pilots. They are used for Search and rescue, training, drownings, and recently hurricane damage documentation.

Jim shared video with us that were taken after Hurricane Irma. After the hurricane, drones were used to help people see damage in their neighborhoods. A Drones line of sight is 4 miles which is farther than the eye can see!

Drones are used where there is other aviation in the area but they must stay below 100 feet. They can be used to help in SWAT operations where manned aircrafts aren't used for safety reasons.

The phantom Pro is the white drone that Tom Parkhurst is holding above, Jim is holding the newest drone called the Maverick that costs around \$1000. They are advanced enough that they can zoom in without being in danger of being shot down. The most advanced drone available costs \$45,000 and is not owned or used by the Sheriff's department.
