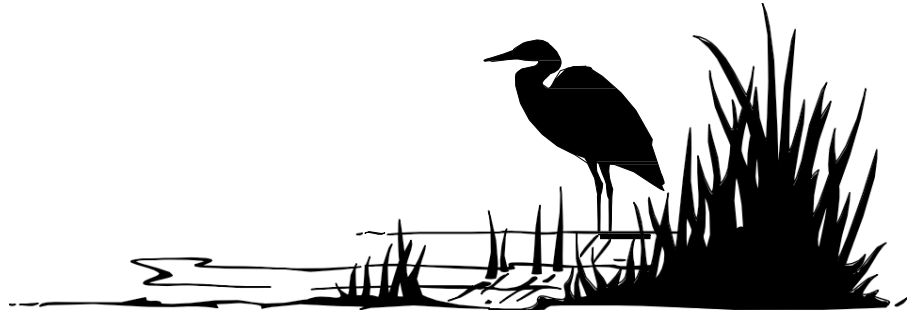

During our January 16th Meeting we heard from Corporal Chris Thomas and his Partner Angela Ison. They are with the Safety Traffic Enforcement unit and are both lucky enough to work everyday on a motor cycle.



Corporal Chris Thomas is retired from the Fairfax motorcycle unit which is Nationally known as one of the best units in the country.

The Collier county unit consists of 10 motorcycles, 2 CanAm's, and 9 permanent officers. Corporal Ison is there to train and learn as they are trying to expand the unit. She shared that Corporal Thomas is one of the best riders she has ever worked with and that he practices all the time and can turn his bike around a penny. Both work on the Traffic Homside Unit.

They shared that Collier County is the safest County in Florida. They start their days at 6:30 AM and work until 6:30 PM working as Traffic Enforcement and Education.

The newspaper recently reported that Nationwide traffic fatalities are sky rocketing de to lower gas prices. Collier county has dropped thee number of fatalities over the past 2 years.

Officers travel in pairs for safety reasons, they can communicate through their helmets as they are blue tooth enabled. They said "4 eyes are better than 2" when they are out on patrol.

Haris shared that because our main roads are wide open with little obstruction to the views, that people tend to speed more. He said that psychologically you think you are safe to speed. Haris pointed out that you will dee more trees on the sides of the roads and they are in an effort to slow down drivers.

Our police force is not allowed to take donations from individuals so there is a club called the 100 club. This club uses donations to help the families of our officers and firefighters. <https://collier100club.org/> Cosmos Café & Pizzeria located at 536 Tamiami Trail is holding a fundraiser on Sunday the 21. \$20 gets you all the food you can eat and all proceeds go to the 100 club.
