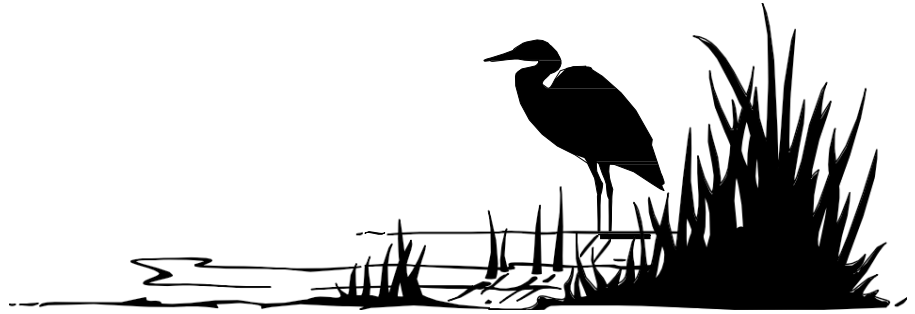

Dr. Jim Gover Served our country during the Korean War as well as during the Vietnam War as a Major in the U.S Airforce. **FIRST AND FOREMOST, THANK YOU SIR FOR YOUR SERVICE TO OUR COUNTRY AND OUR FREEDOM!** Dr. Jim talked about the beginning of the Korean "Conflict." His presentation covered 1950, which was a year of tragic defeats for the Americans, and a few brilliant victories. He explained the events leading up to this situation and outlined the problems in the American political and military establishments that made things worse.
