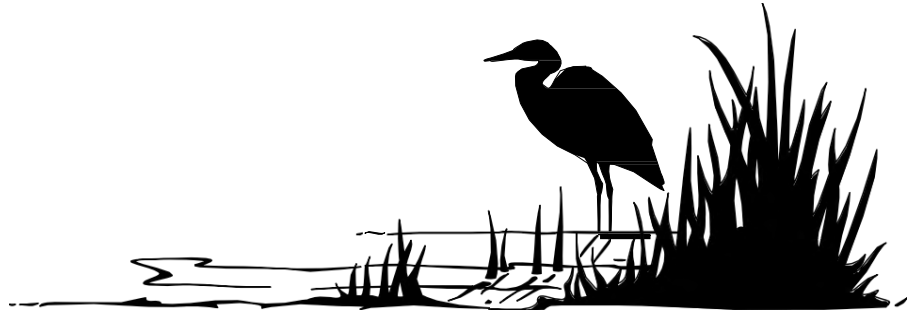

During our meeting on January 23 – We heard from Crime Prevention: Cpl. Jim Klewicki. He said that we have very little violent crime here. We do have distraction theft, this is for example when someone knocks on your door and asks you to look at a tree in the backyard that they are cutting down for the neighbor. While you are in the back yard discussing the tree someone else goes into your house and robs you. Also when you are getting gas, if you leave your purse in the passenger seat then while you are pumping they will open the passenger door and take your purse while you are not looking. Although we live where there is very little violent crime, he said we should still live like we are in Miami.

He pointed out that homes that have a lot of glass are very hard to protect. He shared that the Sheriffs office will come to your home or business and tell you what needs to be done to protect it.

Information about the “See it Say it” campaign was also shared. This is a campaign that asks citizens to contact police if they see anything out of the ordinary.

Additionally Cpl. Klewicki discussed Identity Fraud. He shared that on your credit and debit cards you can set up 2 factor text messages. This will send you a text message every time your card is used. Also, in the future, servers will not be able to walk away from a table with your credit card, your card will have to be processed at the table. This will prevent servers from using credit card skimmers to steal your identity. More information about protecting your identity can be found in the two attachments to this news letter. Did you know that identity theft can also happen at your doctors office? Someone working in they office can sell your medical information for \$50 making it easy for

someone to take your identity. It is important to understand that you will not receive a call from any medical office asking for a payment until you are over 180 days past due. If you get a call earlier than that after any medical procedure you should be aware that it is probably a scam.

Finally, to prevent being robbed, remember to post photos of your trips AFTER you get home, not while you are out of town. This only notifies the public that your house is unattended.

#### **Tips To Secure Your Personal Identity**

- Order a copy of your credit report from each of the three major credit bureaus.

- You are entitled to a free copy from each bureau once a year.
- To order a copy of your credit report, go to <http://www.annualcreditreport.com>
- To order over the phone, call 1-877-322-8228.
- Don't use your home mail box to mail bill payments.
- Shred credit card receipts, credit applications, insurance forms, and anything with your personal information before throwing it in the trash.
- Remove information from your checks, including your Social Security number, phone number, middle name, or driver's license number.
- Close any credit or billing accounts that you no longer use.
- Review your bank and account statements for unusual charges.



- Know your billing cycles and call the company if there are any problems.
- Use passwords on all of your accounts.
- Avoid using birthdays, your mother's maiden name or the last four digits of your Social Security number.
