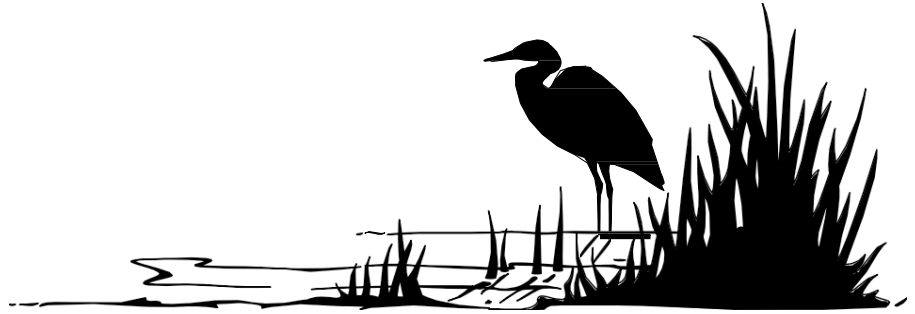

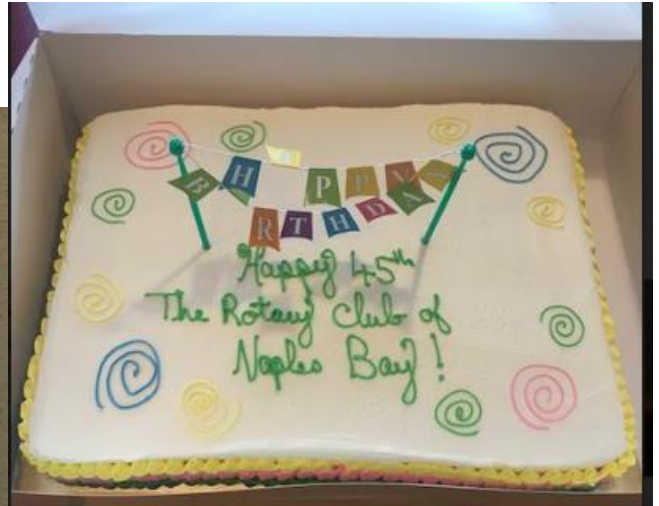

Our speaker on March 20th was Charlie Russel, one of our

visiting Rotarians. Charlie spoke to us about what we can do to help ourselves protect our identity. Charlie has been in Cyber Security for 35 years. He served 2 years in the Marines following up by becoming a Retired Air Force Officer. THANK YOU FOR YOUR SERVICE CHARLIE! In 1967 Charlie was working to fight cyber espionage trying to keep the Russians from stealing our data. They are still trying today!

Charlie said that the #1 problem today is Hacking. This includes phishing, whaling, malware and spying. Charlie shared that you can protect yourself by changing your passwords often. He shared that he has 54 different passwords.

According to Charlie, there have been 5 Mega Breach's, resulting in 72% of all data records being lost. The Internet is a dangerous place to be with your data as 68% of people lose their identity by unexpected exposure on the Web. There is a hacker group known as "Gonzalez" that helped 2 Russians hack Target through their AC system. The AC system worked off of the same frequency's that their Point of Sale system worked from. They successfully stole a couple of million credit card numbers.

Here are some Do's and Don'ts from Charlie:

Do Not

- Do NOT open any messages from organizations you don't know of recognize.
- The IRS and SSA do NOT send emails (most government agencies do not)
- Do NOT share any data with persons you don't know (especially over the phone)
- Do NOT provide your SSN, your personal data or credit card information to anyone unless there's a specific purchase item considered.
- Do Not open emails with any attachments you don't expect (.exe, .pdf, .etc)
- Do Not Visit web sites provided by an organization you don't know.
- Do NOT let your credit card out of your site
- Avoid opening any "link address" that contains misspelled words or names

Do

- Do be wary of your own personal data (medical, financial, etc.), its accuracy and where it is being used especially what you share and where it is stored
- Do buy and install antivirus software on all your computer system and mobile devices
- Do enable and install security updates as soon as possible
- Do consider using encryption for protecting key data
- Do back-up your systems weekly or monthly to a hard drive or to a trusted "Cloud"
