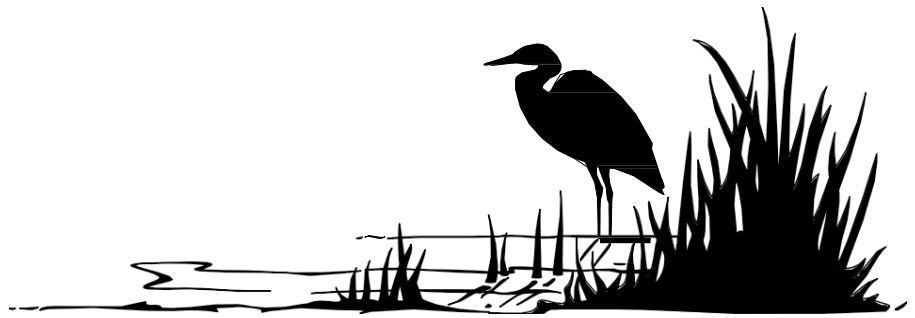

Finally he received his orders and they were not to Alabama, rather he was assigned to base on Look Out Mountain outside of LA, and his job was to make movies! After making movies for the Airforce in parts of Asia he came home and was lucky enough to find a career as an Assistant Director making movies for over 30 years.
