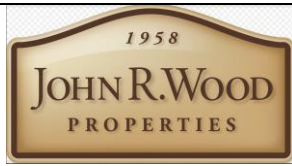

During our meeting on November 20 we heard from Greg Pascucci, the Sales Director at The Carlisle, an Assisted Living and Long Term Care Facility.



Residents that live at the Carlisle enjoy two meals a day during their anytime dining from 7AM to 7PM. They enjoy keeping things a little formal on the weekends with a dress code on Saturdays nights that include no shorts and dinner and the men wear sport's coats in this no smoking facility.

Tom shared that the Carlisle “seems to have a good grasp of building an approach for someone that doesn't need full car, someone that is in between independent and assisted living.” Tom shared that is Mother-in-law is now doing great and is eating and walking and socializing again since he moved her into the Carlisle. Greg added that it is important for residents to socialize with others and that they have happy our every day “we are not a nursing home!”



The Carlisle is an all-inclusive rental property and can provide 24 supervision if needed or residents can bring in their own nursing.

Finally, many assisted living require you to pass a financial and physical exam before moving in. Because there Carlisle is a rental property, there is no buy in required, and no exams. Residents can move out anytime with a 60 day notice.
